Walk of Legends, Green Bay, WI is a free, one-mile public art walkway, east of Lambeau Field featuring 24 statues that chronicle the history & honor the legends of Green Bay football between 1895 & the present. "The Walk" frames the Lombardi Ave. District, with statues located primarily on Lombardi Avenue & other streets named after football legends: Holmgren Way, Brett Favre Pass, Reggie White Way, Bart Starr Dr. & Tony Canadeo Run.
